

My Visit to the Contemporary Art Centre



This is what the Centre's building looks like.



There are parking spaces on the streets around the Centre, including Vokiečių gatvė, Rūdninkų gatvė, and Mėsinių gatvė.



There are three accessible (Type B) parking spaces near the Centre for people with disabilities. The closest space is at Vokiečių gatvė 6. There is another space at Mėsinių gatvė 7 and one more at Žemaitijos gatvė 13.



There are several bus stops near the Centre. The closest one is 'Rotušė'. Bus number 89 stops here. The 'Vingriai' and 'Rūdninkų' bus stops are also nearby.



I will enter the Centre through these doors.



When I enter, I will see the ticket desk. I can get a visitor ticket there.



A staff member of the Centre will greet me at the ticket desk.



I can recognise Centre staff by their badges. Centre staff work at the ticket desk and in the exhibition spaces. I can ask them if I have any questions.



If I want to take off my coat, I can leave it on the coat rack next to the ticket desk.



I can also leave my coat in the cloakroom. I can access it by going down these stairs.



The cloakroom is downstairs. It may be darker there.



I can use the toilet if I wish.



There is also an accessible toilet on the first floor.



Before visiting the exhibitions, I can leave heavy items in the lockers near the ticket desk. I will lock the locker and keep the key safe until the end of my visit.



I will go upstairs using the staircase. The exhibitions are on the second floor.



I can also go to the second floor using the lift by asking a member of staff for help.



I will find the exhibitions in different spaces on the second floor.



I can visit exhibitions in this space.

If I get tired, I can take a chair and sit down. I will find a chair next to the stairs.



I will be careful near these railings
because there is a drop below.



On the second floor, next to the stairs, there is a Cinema Hall. I will find the entrance to the Cinema Hall here.



I can visit the Cinema Hall if I wish.
It is dark inside and may be noisy.



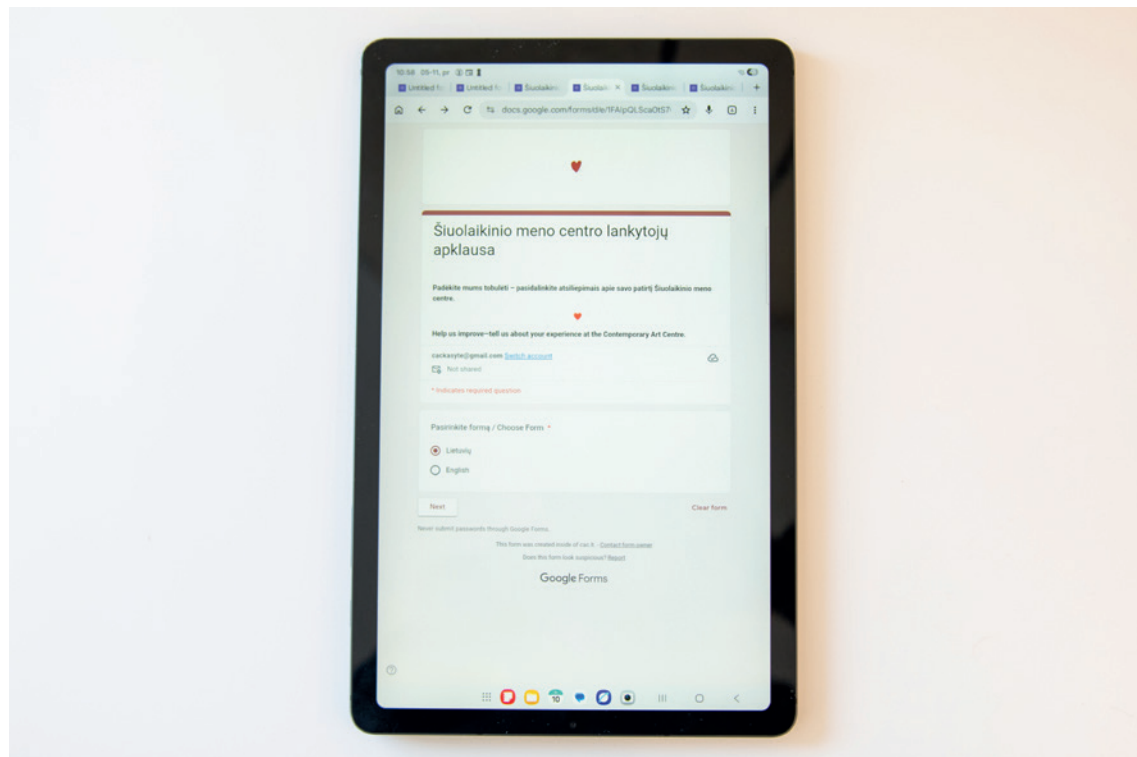
On the second floor, next to the Cinema Hall, I will find a toilet.



Once I have seen everything, I will take the stairs down to the first floor.



I can also go down using the lift by asking a member of staff for help.



After visiting the exhibitions, I can leave feedback at the ticket desk. I can ask a member of staff for help if I need it.



On the first floor, I can visit the Reading Room.



In the Reading Room, I will find books about art.



Here I can sit down and look through these books.



I will find a water station under the stairs. Here I can drink some water.



Inside the Centre, there is a café and shop called 'Raštinē' where I can buy books, drinks, sweet treats, and other items.



Next to the stairs is the entrance to the CAC Café. I can eat there.



I can also enter the Café from the outside by walking along Rūdninku gatvē.



Outside, I will find the Sculpture Yard. I can enter it from Dysnos Street.



In the Sculpture Yard, I will see various sculptures.



Here I can sit down and think about
the artworks I liked.
